

SCHEDULE 1
OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

SNOWBOARD
PART I – SLOPESTYLE AND BIG AIR

- 1 Quota places won for the PyeongChang 2018 Olympic Winter Games (the “**Games**”) are available to the NOC and not to the individual athletes.
- 2 The total number of quota places available for the Slopestyle and Big Air (combined) is 40 for Men and 30 for Women.
- 3 The maximum number of athletes per NOC across all of the Freestyle Ski events (Parallel Giant Slalom, Halfpipe, Snowboard Cross, Slopestyle and Big Air) is 26 (with a maximum of 14 males and 14 females) and is limited to a maximum of four entries per gender in each of those events.

Men

- 4 In the event that the NOC qualifies quota places pursuant to the qualification pathways set out in section D of the IOC/ FIS qualification document dated March 2016 (as may be amended from time to time) (“IOC/FIS Standards”), and subject to paragraph 5 below, the BOA will only accept as nominations for those quota places any individual(s) who:
 - (i) comply with any eligibility criteria as set out in the IOC/FIS Standards, including (but not limited to) Section C; and
 - (ii) in the case of Men, achieve a minimum of two finishes within the top 67% of the field in one or more of the following events during the period 1 July 2016 – 21 January 2018 (the “**Qualification Period**”): a FIS World Cup event, the FIS World Championships 2017, the Dew Tour, X-Games or WST Elite/Invitational; and
 - (iii) in the case of Women, achieve a minimum of two finishes within the top 67% of the field in one or more of the following events during the Qualification Period: a FIS World Cup event, the FIS World Championships 2017, the Dew Tour, the X-Games or SFR Tour.
- 5 The BOA will not accept as qualification for the Games places offered as Tripartite Commission Invitation places or reallocated unused quota places (i.e. handback places, wildcard places or any other quota places which have not been generated by virtue of a direct qualification) unless agreed by the BOA to be in exceptional circumstances pursuant to the BOA PyeongChang 2018 OQS Policy.
- 6 The BOA will consider eligible for selection individual athletes who have been nominated under the BSS Selection Policy for the Games by 22 January 2018.

PART II – SNOWBOARD CROSS

1. Quota places won for the PyeongChang 2018 Olympic Winter Games (the “**Games**”) are available to the NOC and not to the individual athletes.
2. The total number of quota places available for Snowboard Cross is 40 for Men and 30 for Women.
3. The maximum number of athletes per NOC across all of the Freestyle Ski events (Parallel Giant Slalom, Halfpipe, Snowboard Cross, Slopestyle and Big Air) is 26 (with a maximum of 14 males and 14 females) and is limited to a maximum of four entries per gender in each of those events.

Men

4. In the event that the NOC qualifies quota places pursuant to the qualification pathways set out in section D of the IOC/ FIS qualification document dated March 2016 (as may be amended from time to time) (“**IOC/FIS Standards**”), and subject to paragraph 5 below, the BOA will only accept as nominations for those quota places any individual(s) who:
 - (i) comply with any eligibility criteria as set out in the IOC/FIS Standards, including (but not limited to) Section C; and
 - (ii) in the case of Men, achieve a minimum of two finishes within the top 67% of the field in one or more of the following events during the period 1 July 2016 – 21 January 2018 (the “**Qualification Period**”): FIS World Cup events and/or the FIS Snowboard World Championships 2017; and
 - (iii) have a ranking of 100th or better on the FIS Points List of 22 January 2018.
5. The BOA will not accept as qualification for the Games places offered as Tripartite Commission Invitation places or reallocated unused quota places (i.e. handback places, wildcard places or any other quota places which have not been generated by virtue of a direct qualification) unless agreed by the BOA to be in exceptional circumstances pursuant to the BOA PyeongChang 2018 OQS Policy.
6. The BOA will consider eligible for selection individual athletes who have been nominated under the BSS Selection Policy for the Games by 22 January 2018.

PART III – HALFPIPE

1. Quota places won for the PyeongChang 2018 Olympic Winter Games (the “**Games**”) are available to the NOC and not to the individual athletes.
2. The total number of quota places available for the Halfpipe is 30 for Men and 24 for Women.
3. The maximum number of athletes per NOC across all of the Freestyle Ski events (Parallel Giant Slalom, Halfpipe, Snowboard Cross, Slopestyle and Big Air) is 26 (with a maximum of 14 males and 14 females) and is limited to a maximum of four entries per gender in each of those events.
4. In the event that the NOC qualifies quota places pursuant to the qualification pathways set out in section D of the IOC/ FIS qualification document dated March 2016 (as may be amended from time to time) (“**IOC/FIS Standards**”), and subject to paragraph 5 below, the BOA will only accept as nominations for those quota places any individual(s) who:
 - (i) comply with any eligibility criteria as set out in the IOC/FIS Standards, including (but not limited to) Section C; and
 - (ii) achieve a minimum of two finishes within the top 67% of the field in one or more of the following events during the period 1 July 2016 – 21 January 2018 (the “**Qualification Period**”): a FIS World Cup event, the FIS World Championships 2017, the Dew Tour, the X-Games and/or the SFR Tour.
5. The BOA will not accept as qualification for the Games places offered as Tripartite Commission Invitation places or reallocated unused quota places (i.e. handback places, wildcard places or any other quota places which have not been generated by virtue of a direct qualification) unless agreed by the BOA to be in exceptional circumstances pursuant to the BOA PyeongChang 2018 OQS Policy.
6. The BOA will consider eligible for selection individual athletes who have been nominated under the BSS Selection Policy for the Games by 22 January 2018.

PART IV – PARALLEL GIANT SLALOM

1. Quota places won for the PyeongChang 2018 Olympic Winter Games (the “**Games**”) are available to the NOC and not to the individual athletes.
2. The total number of quota places available for the Parallel Giant Slalom is 32 per gender.
3. The maximum number of athletes per NOC across all of the Freestyle Ski events (Parallel Giant Slalom, Halfpipe, Snowboard Cross, Slopestyle and Big Air) is 26 (with a maximum of 14 males and 14 females) and is limited to a maximum of four entries per gender in each of those events.

Men

4. In the event that the NOC qualifies quota places pursuant to the qualification pathways set out in section D of the IOC/ FIS qualification document dated March 2016 (as may be amended from time to time) (“**IOC/FIS Standards**”), and subject to paragraph 5 below, the BOA will only accept as nominations for those quota places any individual(s) who:
 - (i) comply with any eligibility criteria as set out in the IOC/FIS Standards, including (but not limited to) Section C; and
 - (ii) achieve a minimum of two finishes within the top 67% of the field in one or more of a FIS World Cup event and/or the FIS World Championships 2017 during the period 1 July 2016 – 21 January 2018 (the “**Qualification Period**”).
5. The BOA will not accept as qualification for the Games places offered as Tripartite Commission Invitation places or reallocated unused quota places (i.e. handback places, wildcard places or any other quota places which have not been generated by virtue of a direct qualification) unless agreed by the BOA to be in exceptional circumstances pursuant to the BOA PyeongChang 2018 OQS Policy.
6. The BOA will consider eligible for selection individual athletes who have been nominated under the BSS Selection Policy for the Games by 22 January 2018.
